Spooner Health System donated an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) along with both Adult and Infant/Child Pads, valued at \$1,250, to the Shell Lake Arts Center. AED's are computerized devices that are used to defibrillate (shock) someone who is in cardiac arrest. After very little training, most people can use an AED. Becky Busch, Chief Financial Officer at Spooner Health System, serves on the Development Committee for the Shell Lake Arts Center. "The Arts Center identified the need to have an AED, especially for all of their summer camps," said Busch. "SHS is happy to provide them with this important medical equipment."
